Least-Visited States

Hikers don't need to confine themselves to Yellowstone for some of Wyoming's most beautiful scenery. Killpecker Dunes, part of Wyoming's Red Desert and where you'll find some of Wyoming's best hikes, is home to miles of towering sand dunes and dotted with otherworldly rock formations. The Boars Tusk, a 400-foot monolith, is the core of a volcano exposed by the erosion of the surrounding rock, and you can hike three miles to the spire.

Here's How to Visit Sweetwater County, Wyoming

Sweetwater County is home to dormant volcanoes, more than 1,000 horses in the Pilot Butte Wild Horse Scenic Loop, a huge migrating herd of pronghorn, the white Killpecker Sand Dunes and the spectacular 91-mile Flaming Gorge. The Red Desert is the biggest unfenced desert landscape in the Lower 48 states, containing nine Wilderness Study Areas.
